It has been an exciting few months for our new club. Yes, I said *new club*, even though the Desert Wranglers have been



around since 2010. However, at the end of 2021,

our patron dealership cut us loose and thought we would disband.

Instead, we re-organized as an independent, Nevada non-profit, all volunteer, Jeep club. Soon we will be a federally approved 501(c)3 charitable & educational organization.

Rebuilding was neither an easy, nor inexpensive task. All of our start-up and operating expenses were fronted out-of-pocket by the Leadership team.

Fred Ginsburg and Judi Taylor



led the effort to resurrect Desert Wranglers, and soon we had an effective team of dedi-

cated and hard-working volunteers from which we formed our new Leadership.

Trail Runs

It's all about the Trail Runs; pretty much everything else is a byproduct. Under the tutelage of our Trail Masters Jim and Judi Taylor — Desert Wranglers

have been getting dirty again!

May, June, and July have seen a steady increase in scheduled

runs: **Over 12 so far**. That's not including the pre-runs and training runs for potential Leaders & Gunners.

On July 10th, we even had two successful trail runs involving a total of nearly 30 Jeeps!

We're always looking for more individuals to organize and lead runs. Contact Jim or Judy.

Websites

We've grown from a mere Face-Book Group to being a bona fide organization.

Our new website, found at www.desertwranglers.club serves as our base, telling the community who we are, what we do, how to join, and includes links to educational and

jeep related local resources.

It is a work in progress, but our



webmaster Patti Zapparolli is continually adding new material everyday.

On our new website you will find lots of useful information including: Club Bylaws, Trail Ratings & Descriptions, a monthly Events Calendar (but use Meetup for details & RSVP), FAQ, Join, Documents and Links.

A couple new sections are under construction. A directory of favorite local "go to" vendors, submitted by members. Send your recommendations to Patti or Steve via our club email (desertwranglers@gmail.com)

Soon there will be a link to purchase a wide variety of Desert Wranglers logo merchandise direct from our supplier.

Our **FaceBook Group** is still an active site, but it functions primarily as a FORUM & DISCUS-SION THREAD for individual/personal posts.

Meetup is used for posting details about our Club Trail Runs & Events, since it allows us to restrict specific details to only Ac-

tive Members. We like its RSVP functionality, since it gives us the capability of lim-



iting the number of attendees while creating a Wait List.

Our search

ability (SEO) on Google has been improved. We place quickly in the search engine, along with a featured business insert.

Membership

DW dates back to 2010, so we began with a mailing list with thousands of names. Some were relatively active; many had moved on or faded away; and hundreds were just couch potatoes living in their imaginary virtual worlds.

We began to purge the names of "members" who showed no activity within the last couple of years. But we were still left with stacks of names and expired emails.

The Board decided that we needed an accurate roster. Our sign-up process on the website generates an excel database, from which we can easily search and manage our rolls.

We have asked everyone to please **RE-JOIN** the Desert Wranglers by going to the sign-up page on our website.

Once you have re-joined, you will automatically be taken to a page where you can submit your \$25 annual membership dues.

The dues are per Jeep household, so that your co-driver and passengers do not need to join individually.

To date, over 120 people have re-joined, paid their dues, and are Active Members!

Treasury

Until we achieved legal status in the state — Desert Wranglers had zero money, could not open any kind of a bank account, receive dues or donations, nor even pay for a meeting room.

So the club founders had to dig into our pockets and cover our start-up expenses,

such as: domain registrations & website hosting; Meetup subscription; mailbox w street address; state and federal application filing fees; software; opening bank deposit; and more. Roughly 1500 bucks!

Today, we are a legal entity. We have a checking account at America First Credit Union, a Square account for online transactions (membership dues), and a PayPal account (for logo merchandise sales).



Our accounting records are maintained in Quicken, and routinely monitored — not just by our **Club Treasurer Dave Traver** — but also by Fred and members of the Board.

Sponsorships

As a club, the Desert Wranglers has a lot to offer to potential sponsors.

We boast over 120 Active Members, meaning that they are serious enough to have paid their dues. Probably over 150 by the time you read this.

In addition, there are hundreds of Associate Members (aka *followers* who haven't yet officially re-joined nor paid their dues) on our FaceBook and Meetup pages. That's not even counting the numerous visits to our website from curious Jeep owners all over the country.

That's a lot of Jeeps! I can't imagine any good Marketing Director who wouldn't want a direct line to us!

So far, two companies have come on board.

OnX Off-road is offering our members a 20% discount towards the purchase of their GPS navigation/mapping software. You can get a two-month free trial of their Elite software if you just want to try it out. OnX has provided us with a couple free subscriptions as door prizes.

Heatbeaters Headliners offers a 15% discount to active club members.

Our Jeep community big brother, **Vegas Valley 4Wheelers** has donated \$500 to help get us on our feet, along with the offer of future club to club assistance. We cannot thank them enough.

But helping VV4W to staff their upcoming **Hump & Bump** Event in October would certainly be a good way for us to show our appreciation!

Education & Training

One of our mission goals is to educate our members. Steve is putting together an ongoing series of training events, along with articles & links on our website.

This month (July 2022) we will feature GPS navigation software. An overview will be presented at our meeting; to be followed by indetail hands-on smaller classes for people who are seriously interested.

Special Events

Upcoming major events include VV4W's Hump & Bump* in October; Jeeper Kreepers' Jeeps & Treats* Halloween Night; St. George Winter 4x4 Jamboree. *DW has been asked to help out our community at the two local events.

Chairs to Fill

The more we do... the more people we need to help manage our club.

Special Events Chair Desert Wranglers can be more than just driving out Jeeps. A few times per year we will try to schedule some social activities, such as Holiday Parties, picnics/BBQ's, or attending some local fun activity (medieval faire, concerts, shooting range, overnight travel, or whatever).

Media Relations Chair This person would browse the internet, looking for mentions of Desert Wranglers in relevant forums (Jeeps, off-roading, etc) and submit posts to update those older posts.

Front-End Web Developer Assist the web master with researching features, API keys, and web design skills HTML, CSS

Web Designer Assist the web master with creating pages, updating content, designing web pages/funnels. Experience using website platforms such as Wix, Squarespace, or Word Press, or other similar tools is required. Experience with payment processors/ platforms and integrations a plus.

Back-End Web Developer or Full-Stack Web Developer This position is highly desired, in order to take our website to the next level. Skills in Python, Java, PHP, SQL, Git, HTML, CSS, JavaScript

A Brief History of the Desert Wranglers

Desert Wranglers was initially created and sponsored in 2010 by *Chapman Chrysler Jeep Dodge Ram* (aka Chapman) located in Henderson Nevada.

The dealership envisioned the club as a means to help their customers and other Wrangler owners in the Las



Vegas area become familiar with their Jeeps and to introduce them

to the local trail systems in the area. Monthly General Meetings were held at their Chapman Used Car dealership over on Warms Springs in Henderson.

Since the club was entirely sponsored by Chapman, there was no need to charge dues for membership.

In 2020 Chapman suspended club activity due to the Covid pandemic.

As activity started to resume, Chapman corporate decided to move in an entirely different direction regarding club sponsorship. They wanted to be more inclusive of all Jeep branded

vehicles and no longer focus exclusively on Wranglers.

The two entities decided that if both were to achieve their respective goals, it would be best for each take a different trail.

Chapman's new Chapman Jeep Club is still in the concept state, although the dealership did host a taco event for Jeepers in their parking lot.

It's been 12 years since the start of DW, and our club interest was still very strong! While it was wonderful having Chapman graciously sponsor the club for as long as they did — it came down to the members. We wanted our Desert Wranglers back!

Months went by without club activities. In March of 2022, a core group of Desert Wranglers from the original club pulled together and decided to revive the Club into what is today the new Desert Wranglers Jeep Club.

We are now a certified Non-Profit Organization in the State of Nevada and soon to become a 501c3 federally recognized Charitable & Educational association. Our mission is to assist our members in learning how to safely and responsibly wheel off-road; as well as supporting Local, State and Federal Agencies in the maintenance and preservation of our local Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) Trails.

Desert Wranglers are family friendly, and openly welcome beginners who may lack any prior off-road experience.


